Expert Australian Pharmacologist Speaks Out

As the number of dead and seriously and/or permanently disabled caused by the Covid-19 injections, reaches heights beyond imagination, the question now is... who needs to be prosecuted?

COVID-19 jabs are now known to have been falsely promoted to the public as 'vaccines', and the Department of Defence (US) that controlled the research on these products, states they are in fact classified as countermeasures or bioweapons – not pharmaceuticals. Due to their experimental nature, they are best described as experimental emergency medical countermeasures (EEMCs) and there was never any evidence to claim that they could prevent disease in healthy people or that they were safe in most people.

The question of who should be prosecuted over this medical fraud is an easy question to answer

in the case of those who plotted, planned and benefited from this crime against humanity. The Covid-19 injections have caused more death and serious injury than any pharmaceutical product in history. (Note: these genetically modified mRNA injections were not developed to the standards of conventional 'pharmaceuticals').

In order to decide who should be held accountable, the commonly used phrase "what did they know and when did they know it" springs to mind. This could be a useful demarcation line.

Anyone working within the national adverse drug reporting systems now knows, or should know, the truth. In order to suppress the deadly toll of the Covid-19 injections, there must be active and purposeful cover up or manipulation of data. In my view, the people doing this have



criminal exposure that should be the first target for prosecution, as it is primarily this corrupted data that Big Pharma clings to in order to claim 'safety' for the 'vaccines' and keep this facade going.

The senior bureaucrat so-called 'health experts' who continue to make Covid-19 'vaccine' policy and support mandatory vaccination, also have exposure. Ignorance is no longer an excuse. Who Trusts the WHO?

Pandemic treaty madness!

THE Australian government's devotion to global health policies and the World Health Organisation (WHO) has remained strong even though there was a public backlash against the new amendments to the International Health Regulations (IHR) just before Scott Morrison was voted out of office.

Australia is still working closely with WHO officials on the amendments to the IHR and the Pandemic Preparedness Treaty that will be approved for the 2023-24 period. This is extremely concerning because the negotiating body is demanding that new powers be given to the WHO that will enable the director to take complete control of Australia's response whenever the WHO declares another public health emergency.

These are significant new powers that would enable unelected WHO officials to dictate a uniform response to all WHO member countries. In effect, a one world government that could mandate all the recent public health emergency directives, that were demonstrated to be flawed, without government veto.

Unfortunately, very few people know that the new amendments to the IHR or the Pandemic Treaty are back on the table, as the government and media have not publicised this fact widely. I wonder why? There is a lot at risk for the public should these powers be given to the WHO, including the removal of Australians fundamental right to bodily autonomy, freedom of movement and freedom of speech.

The powers under the current IHR only allow the WHO to 'recommend' directives to be implemented for each WHO member country. However, the fact that the WHO directives are often linked to significant financial incentives means that most member countries do implement them.

It is the National Technical and Advisory Groups on Immunisation

If the new amendments to the IHR are passed or the Pandemic Treaty, the Director-General of the WHO could dictate Australia's federal and state health policy against the best interests of the people.

(NTAGI) that are set up in each WHO member country that make recommendations to the government on WHO global health policies. The reason these directives are only recommended, and not mandatory, is because uniform global health policies do not account for the specific differences in environmental and host characteristics in each country, that are significant determinants of health outcomes to infectious diseases.

Australia should never base its public health policy on data from other countries, yet this is what global health policies require countries to do. Further, since 1999 when the Global Alliance for Vaccines and Immunisation (GAVI) was formed by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, the Global Health Policies have been dominated by advice on vaccination policies from this GAVI alliance – a body of private-public partnerships that exists outside of the WHO.

The GAVI alliance includes the Federation of Pharmaceutical companies, biotechnology companies, the International Monetary Fund, the World Bank and governments, all of whom can influence the design of WHO Global Health Policies. This is how public health has been tied to the economy of all WHO member countries and why all countries were in lockdown for the last alleged WHO pandemic in 2020.

The existence of the GAVI alliance and its influence in the design of global health policies, that the public is not informed about, is a breach of the WHO's charter to use independent

science in health promotion. This is because the pharmaceutical companies and biotechnology companies are directly profiting from their advice.

If the new amendments to the IHR are passed or the Pandemic Treaty, the Director-General of the WHO could dictate Australia's federal and state health policy against the best interests of the people. Currently this position is held by Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus.

The treaty represents a removal of democracy in Australia that could lead to Australians being locked down, detained, and medicated without justification, and in breach of our civil liberties – as we have just experienced over the last three years under coercive WHO policies that included financial incentives for governments if they implemented them.

During the last WHO declared public health emergency nations were denied the opportunity to challenge or debate the WHO's solution, even though it contradicted Australia's own public health policies that have protected Australians for decades against all infectious diseases.

This lack of debate on infectious disease control has resulted in lockdowns and mandatory medication policies that have killed and harmed millions of healthy people globally.

Most people would presume that there are specific conditions and requirements that must be met before the IHR's are triggered in the case of a public health emergency. But there are none.

A pandemic can be declared on the whim of the WHO Director-General, paving the way for 'climate lockdowns' and 'health pandemics' with solutions that ignore the diversity of environments and the genetics of populations. At the same time the WHO can mandate a pharmaceutical solution that creates significant profits for industry and comes with a serious risk to many healthy people –



which also creates profits for the medical-industry.

Fortunately, the first version of the Pandemic Treaty was voted down last year by a group of 42-member African nations. However, they have now been offered money, technology and resources in exchange for their support in the next vote.

The only way to stop the new amendments to the IHR is through public pressure and awareness. Another meeting to approve the amendments will occur in May 2023. As a nation we need to maintain our sovereignty to ensure that policies are implemented in the best interests of Australians, and not those of corporations or other vested interests.

The new amendments to the IHR propose allowing health 'stakeholders' such as vaccine companies to sit as voting members of the WHO with the same weight as Australia. This would put Big Pharma in the position of directly ordering mandatory vaccinations which they would then sell under duress through the WHO. Currently, this already happens as a 'recommendation' from

the GAVI alliance, but now the pharmaceutical companies want direct voting rights through the WHO.

We now await the final amendments to the IHR that will be added in May 2023 and voted upon in May 2024. The IHR amendments include a provision that they will become binding on all Australians as soon as Australia's WHO representative signs it.

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How to stay private and anonymous online

EVERYONE, regardless of where they stand on social or ideological issues, is a target in a war against human freedom. Right now, if you use Microsoft, Google, or Apple operating systems on your devices, you are being spied on, in real time.

For a start, there is a common misconception that email is secure. Nothing could be further from the truth.

'Isn't Protonmail secure?'

Sadly, it's not. A climate activist in France found this out the hard way when the 'Secure Email Based in Switzerland, that many of us rely on, revealed his IP address to Swiss authorities, resulting in his being arrested.

Email is not secure by default. Most email services are unencrypted when emails are sent. Even if you are using encrypted email, the people you communicate with might not be. Secure, blockchain-based messaging is the future. So, what should you use?

If your communication is sensitive, consider using end-to-end encrypted messaging apps like Session, which doesn't require an email or number.

For Session on your mobile, it's imperative to download direct from Getsession.org and use the APK setup, ensuring you're not using a version relying on Google Play.

Telegram is great, but shouldn't be considered fully secure. With Telegram, it's best to use the Desktop app, and avoid App Store versions, which contain censorship from Apple and Google. The original Telegram from their website is all blue. App store Telegram has a white border to the icon, and is compromised.

When accessing the internet without encryption, information can be inspected in real time. You should use a high-quality VPN. There are many VPN's, but most leak your metadata.

The most secure VPN we've vetted is Mullvad.net.

Mullvad is inexpensive, and one of the reasons they're the best VPN, if you wish to be completely anonymous, is that you're able to pay using anonymous crypto such

as Monero. There's an article on Activists Toolbox website under 'Online security and anonymity' on buying crypto anonymously.

The more common browsers for improved security are Brave and Tor Browser for PC, and Bromite for mobile.

For Linux users, we recommend using LibreWolf browser. When installing, we use the Flatpak installation method and recommend installing the "Decentraleyes" add-on. Decentraleyes stops a surveillance tactic known as content delivery network (CDN) scraping.

We've discussed emails, messaging and browsers... now let's get to the core solutions to your online privacy.

Most computers come with Windows or Apple pre-installed as the operating system. Both have contact tracing built in, meaning your computer is watching you everywhere you go. We won't go into all of the things that Microsoft and Apple OS's are capable of from a surveillance perspective, but it doesn't matter how much security software you install on them, your OS is spying on you.

The bottom line, you ask? You should stop using their products as soon as possible. It's time to move to Linux.

There are many versions of Linux that you can use. We recommend going for Linux Mint as it's very similar to Windows, therefore the easiest to migrate to. Check out videos online comparing

Linux Mint to Windows if you have doubts about whether you could take on this migration.

With technical skills, migrating a Windows machine to Linux Mint should be easy enough for you. Ensure your machine is compatible and that you are sure on taking on the install. There are many great tutorials online, or get a Linux laptop at the Activists Toolbox store.

Smartphones gather your data, capturing in great detail who you are, your location, and what you're doing 24/7.

The best way to combat this is to buy a De-Googled phone. This is an Android phone that has been stripped of its default OS, including all tracking and spyware, and replaced with a custom ROM such as LineageOS. These custom ROM's function just like regular Android, but are free from any spying and bloatware. This also means the longevity of your battery and device improves too!

It's then best to use a pay-as-you-go sim card that's not in your name, and avoid apps that utilise your personal data.

We hope this provides you with a basic overview on what steps need to be taken to feel secure whilst using your devices.

How bots are used to change your behaviour

DO you sometimes turn on social media and wonder, how on earth can that message, or that individual be so incredibly popular?

As a case in point, Gary Lineker recently tweeted out the inane statement that 'Scotland is very beautiful', and that pearl of wisdom received an astounding 27,000 likes on Twitter. Did twenty-seven thousand people have nothing better to do than like this fatuous statement? In fact, almost everything that Gary Lineker writes achieves this outlandish level of praise.

In our research work, we have found that in many cases where the level of popularity doesn't seem credible, the answer is often because individuals and certain messages are amplified by bots.

There is a lot of debate over the size of the bot problem; Twitter only accepts that up to five per cent of its 229 million monetisable daily active users are spam accounts, but in data-science circles, many estimates are well over half (our own estimate is around 80 per cent of politics-related likes and retweets are automated or produced by activists).

Fake likes and retweets are generated by a range of tools, ranging from some bolt-on Twitter features for regular users (Hootsuite), to manufacturing completely fake accounts (TweetAttacksPro). In the former case, a single user can operate multiple accounts to amplify what they are doing; this is something that political activists often do. In the latter case, it is possible to programme tens of thousands of fake accounts to follow specified Twitter users, and provide likes and retweets. A simple scroll through the ludicrous 35.6 million followers that Joe Biden has on Twitter will show thousands of bot followers hidden below a number of legitimate followers.

Generally, left-of-centre political messages receive a lot of amplification; typical topics will include vaccine mandates and state intervention in the economy. Former 'Dragon', Deborah Meaden, is an example of an ardent EU Remainder whose

Twitter account is boosted by bots.

The purpose of falsifying the popularity of a particular message (or individual) is to create the false impression that there is popular support for it.

In the language of nudging, this is called establishing norms, forming the N in the MINDSPACE acronym which the government's Behavioural Insights Team developed.

With this technique, the creation of norms is considered to be important because we are strongly influenced by what others do. Therefore, there is a behavioural science benefit to establishing something as normal and widely-supported.

In social media, there are more mundane business objectives, with a number of charlatans having their accounts boosted by bots to create a media presence. One classic case is James Melville, who spent a few months with *Byline Times*, yet his follower base on Twitter of 350,000 apparently dwarfs the readership of well-established journalists such as Peter Hitchens and Alison Pearson.

In addition to dishonestly promoting certain messages, the bots also put genuine content at a serious disadvantage, since in the absence of bot amplification, genuine traffic with relatively fewer likes can appear at the bottom of timelines, and will never feature in the trending section. This deliberate strategy was referred to in the Event 201 pandemic planning exercise carried out in October 2019 as 'flooding the zone'. This ensures that only the official state position is heard, both in broadcast and on social media.

So the next time that you see a strange idea, or unlikely individual basking in social media adulation, don't get confused, but do wonder instead whether this outcome was achieved using automated bot traffic.

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Historical precedents for the New World Order

AS trade unions in essential services around the country campaign for pay and conditions, disenchanted workers ask why they failed to go on strike against the Covid mandates. Decisive action by essential services could have stopped the murderous tragedy of mass injections at the outset. Why did so many people fail to do their duty?

Writing in his Italian gaol cell 90 years ago, the political prisoner Antonio Gramsci answered this very question.

“Between consent and force stand corruption/fraud (which is characteristic of certain situations when it is hard to exercise the hegemonic function, and when the use of force is too risky). This consists in procuring the demoralisation and paralysis of the antagonist (or antagonists) by buying its leaders – either covertly or, in the case of imminent danger, openly – in order to sow disarray and confusion in its ranks.”

The late Italian economist, sociologist and world systems analyst, Prof Giovanni Arrighi, quotes the above passage from Gramsci’s Prison Notebooks in his book, *The Long 20th Century*, where he refers to the work of anthropologists Edward Evans-Pritchard and Max Gluckman with

early societies in Africa and their concept of ordered anarchy.

Writes Arrighi: “ ‘Chaos and systemic chaos,’ in contrast, refer to a situation of total and apparently irremediable lack of organisation. It is a situation that arises because conflict escalates beyond the threshold within which it calls forth powerful countervailing tendencies or because

a new set of rules and norms of behaviour is imposed on, or grows from within, an older set of rules and norms without displacing it, or because of a combination of those two circumstances.

“As systemic chaos increases, the demand for ‘order’ – the old order, a new order, any order – tends to become more and more general among rulers,

or among subjects, or both. Whichever State or group of States is in a position to satisfy this system-wide demand for order is thus presented with the opportunity of becoming world hegemonic.” (My emphasis)

Did the masters of the universe study this history as they planned the Covid project and the Great Reset? You bet they did. These creeps are

crazy but they are not stupid and as they sipped their after-conference drinkies at Davos in January they marvelled at the speed of their triumph. It all went according to plan.

Destroy the population’s physical, mental and financial health. Create scarcity and drive inflation by disrupting supply chains. Melt down currencies. Reduce the masses to such chaotic desperation that they seek order – to quote Arrighi – the old order, a new order, any order.

Steal their assets and cash and give them the ultimate order – the Great Reset. They will own nothing but they will be happy with their digital pocket money and they will do as they are told.

Humanity faces a struggle for survival. It would have been easier if our trade unions and professional associations served their members instead of their masters.

Whatever happened to the future?

IN the nineteenth century, Queen Victoria reigned in half of the world. It was said that the sun never sets on the British Empire, ubiquitously coloured pink on Mercator’s projection.

After the carnage of the First World War in Europe, the American century was established. But as blatantly shown by the administration of Joe Biden, the Washington establishment is abandoning American exceptionalism for a new world order in which no single nation shall dominate. We are well into the third century of globalism: a post-democratic, postliberal, post-traditional technocracy.

The British Empire was fired by coal, the Pax Americana by oil, and the global technocracy by silicon. For all their faults, the British imperialists propagated their civic systems and institutions. The neocolonial Americans elevated popular culture above religion and ritual; although the

USA was never really ‘the land of the free’, it was widely regarded as a land of opportunity. It seemed, particularly after the emancipatory movements of the 1960s, and later by the collapse of Soviet communism, that we were heading inexorably towards the sunlit uplands of liberating modernity.

The internet initially appeared to hasten this process. But it soon became a double-edged sword, as authoritarians used it for surveillance. Now the early dreams have been dashed by an unholy alliance between governments and Big Tech to control the narrative by systematic censorship. The information superhighway is becoming a control grid.

Drawing patterns across the complexity of history is, unavoidably, a simplification. As well as the British ruling class and American ‘deep state’, globalisation has involved other important actors: industrial Germany (whose leading scientists under the Third Reich were brought to the USA by Operation Paperclip), the Jewish intelligentsia (mostly a force for good, but also

including the cultural Marxists of the Frankfurt School and Hollywood moguls pushing propaganda), global bankers and corporations, wealthy dynasties such as the Rockefellers (who monetised philanthropy), and of course transnational organisations such as the Bilderberg Group, Trilateral Commission and World Economic Forum that pursue one world government.

Since its revolution in 1949, China has been perceived by outsiders as an oppressive regime. Yet behind the scenes, globalists have seen the Chinese way as the future: a collectivist society brought under technocratic tutelage. Its electronic monitoring of citizens, known as the social credit system, may seem dystopian to ordinary people acclimatised to liberal democracy. However, as shown by Covid-19, our leaders have relinquished national autonomy to sign up to dictatorial globalism. The purported pandemic was one of a pair of Trojan Horses alongside the preposterous climate change crisis. China demonstrated not



only a radical lockdown to the world, but also brutal policing methods (allegedly the violent Victoria state police under the authority of Covid-19 zealot Dan Andrews were trained by the Chinese). After the tyrannical rule of Mao Zedong, China was helped by the West to become an economic powerhouse. While facing outwards with rapacious capitalism, its communist system maintains internal discipline, exploiting technological advances to record every person’s movements. Under these conditions, China has been a testing ground for technocracy.

Western figures such as Justin Trudeau laud China because its totalitarianism allows society to be transformed to an extent that European and American globalists would like, but cannot readily impose due to lingering traditions of faith, flag and family. But they have made great strides with Covid-19. The WA Police Challenge to Government Medical Mandates: Were They Legal?

In The Beginning

TOWARDS the end of 2021, the Western Australian (WA) Premier, Mark McGowan, implemented a directive that mandated 75% of WA employees to be 'fully vaccinated' against Covid-19 to go to work. This was despite the Federal Government stating that vaccination in Australia is voluntary. It followed the disgraceful regional lockdowns and total ban on interstate and international travel.

At this time, the WA Police Force issued an employee direction for all sworn officers to have one jab by 1st December and the 2nd by the end of December 2021 unless they held a medical exemption. I was then and remain today deeply troubled by this order and by our State and Federal governments' handling of the Covid-19 threat.

Doctors are required by their medical ethical guidelines to provide informed consent to all medical interventions "without coercion, manipulation or pressure" (Australian Immunisation Handbook Ed.10). Yet in 2021, the Western Australian government, without a workplace risk assessment, coerced employees with their livelihoods to take this newly developed mRNA gene technology that was being called a 'vaccine'.

In October 2022, Pfizer executive Janine Small admitted that the company had never adequately tested the Covid-19 injections to see if they prevented the disease or transmission. The Pfizer documents also showed that they were only tested in small clinical trials for two months before being mandated in human populations. A vaccine is a preventative measure, not a treatment. The only reason for mandating an injection in a healthy person is if it is known to prevent the disease and if it is known to be safe in the long term.

I was initially concerned about Covid-19 disease when it emerged in

early 2020, but I followed the public health statistics and medical journals and not just the government rhetoric and highly shaped media narrative. By mid 2020, I was well aware that Covid-19 was, at worst, a severe influenza-type virus for the elderly and mild for the young. Yet, it was surrounded by enormous political and media momentum to maintain public fear that it was worse than it actually was.

In the weeks leading up to the December deadline to get the jab, I was already in contact with over a hundred sworn and unsworn staff that all held concerns about the direction to get the jab. My concern about the ramifications of stepping out of line was overtaken by my fear of what would happen if I didn't. I believed then and still hold, that our nation

was mimicking portions of behavior exhibited by the most tyrannical dictatorships from the previous century. I feared that if left unchecked, the practice would soon be perfected and produce the same dystopian fruit as it has before.

Simply put, I believe our fundamental human rights and individual liberties are being stripped away by an unchecked authoritarian government. I think the mandates are unjust, and the order to get vaccinated is unlawful.

The Judicial Review Trial and Outcome

I was among a courageous few who contacted and retained lawyers to act out legal plans to challenge the decisions of my employer and our State government by commencing a judicial review. From the outset, we wanted to check and hopefully overturn the government's ability to issue mandates and shaped our legal arguments seeking relief for all WA workers, not just those employed in the WA Police Force.

Although we were very skeptical about the 'vaccines', we wanted to attack the mandates on purely legal grounds. Similar cases challenging the 'science' weren't gaining traction in other states. Instead, we shaped our case around challenging the lawfulness and proportionality of the employee directions and mandates. The judicial review hearing eventually took place in July 2022. Still, most of the battle was fought in the preceding months with intense back-and-forth arguing between our lawyers and the State. It was about the precise argument being presented to the court and if or how either side would be allowed to give expert evidence.

The trial had its exciting moments. However, an onlooker only seeing the trial, would have missed much of the evidence presented to the court in document form, in the lead up to the hearing.

In August 2022, the court handed down its decision and dismissed all three of our cases. This outcome was unwanted but not unexpected, and our lawyers immediately began shaping grounds to appeal the decisions, which have now been submitted to the WA Court of Appeal.

The Road Ahead

The appeal hearing date has yet to be scheduled by the court, but is speculated to occur around mid 2023.

Recently, our lawyers sought an interlocutory injunction from the WA Court of Appeal, which was granted, restraining the Commissioner of Police from dismissing me until the appeal outcome is known. This means I have been stood down on full pay since December 2021 despite being willing, ready and able to work throughout the period. Further, the mandate that required me to be jabbed was dropped in June 2022.

The narrative around the effectiveness of the Covid-19 jabs is in tatters. The virus itself appears to only exist in ambiguous testing results, with deaths usually occurring in the elderly or those with other severe co-morbidities. Yet now the government and media are ignoring the unexplained spike in all-cause mortality data. I believe it is time we stopped following the 'science' and started following the evidence. As with any reasonable fraud investigation, we should begin by following the money.

Our current legal team has expressed a willingness to take the judicial review matter to the Australian High Court if relief is not found in the WA Court of Appeal. 

ESG - socialism disguised as free market capitalism

AS a State Treasurer, I operate at the intersection of politics and capital markets, squarely where ESG resides. Many are afraid to speak out about it, but people need to understand the threat that it poses to our system, one based on free-market capitalism and constitutional principles.

ESG uses economic force to drive a political agenda through corporate America. As Larry Fink, CEO of BlackRock, the largest investment manager in the world, so succinctly stated: “You have to force behaviours, and at BlackRock, we’re forcing behaviours.”

BlackRock manages \$10 trillion of other people’s money. Other investment managers have trillions more. Unelected by anyone, they are using the might of other people’s capital to drive a far-left agenda. Arguably, no one outside the federal government has more power, and few people outside the industry know what’s going on.

There’s a small tech company in my state of Utah that employs fewer than 75 people. A Silicon Valley tech titan was a client. Call it Twoogle. Last year, Twoogle explained to the company that if they wanted to continue to do business with Twoogle, they would need to implement a whole range of policies.

For example, the Utah company would have to provide six months of full pay and benefits for maternity and paternity leave. The company responded that Utah’s fertility rates are higher than other states, and offering the benefit to all employees would imperil the company financially. Since fewer than five employees served the Twoogle account, they asked if they could implement the policy for just those employees.

Twoogle said no, they must implement the benefit regardless of the financial impact.

That every employee knew what benefits the company offered before they agreed to work there was beside the point. The tech company was forced to drop Twoogle as a client - a serious blow.

And what about Twoogle? Presumably, they engaged the

company because they had the best product at the best price. They, too, will pay a price for their policies when they move to the next-best provider. How is this good for Twoogle’s shareholders?

This is just one small example of how ESG plays out across our economy. Multiply it by a million.

ESG is a political scoring system for investors, with companies like S&P Global issuing ESG scores on corporations. It sounds great, right? In reality, ESG is dictatorship in capitalist clothing. Our banks, investment managers and corporations are all promoting ESG, cleverly lending ESG the veneer of free-market capitalism. But it is not capitalism.

Capitalism is freedom in an economic context. ESG is a system of force. ESG substitutes our pluralistic institutions for conformity to centralised power, one that makes up the rules as it goes. If you don’t believe me, think about the indeterminate nature of ESG. There are two layers of subjectivity: the determination of the ESG factors themselves and the answers to those factors. If you ask people what the factors should be, you will get different answers depending on their shade of politics.

Even if people agree on the factors, the answers as to what constitutes a ‘good’ or a ‘bad’ score for a particular factor also depends on whom you ask. Is British Petroleum

bad because it sells oil or good because of its focus on developing alternatives?

This is an inherently political exercise, and ESG cedes power to the entities determining those two central questions. Government bureaucrats appear to be colluding with investment behemoths like BlackRock to make the agenda, and they use the threat of regulation and the power of our investment money to bully corporate America into carrying it out.

What would prevent new factors from being used as a weapon against the other side? For example, what if the government, under different party control, suddenly decided to use capital to favour donations to pro-life groups? I would oppose this on the same grounds. We need to keep our capital markets and businesses politically neutral.

Pension allocators, most of whom are government employees, are also in on the game. As one insider put it, they are “effectively creating law and enforcing it without voter input, debate, or even knowledge. Given their size, their standards flow downstream, changing everything.”

Why, you may ask, is any of this a problem for the average person? Well, why are gas prices so high?

In the past, capital would have flowed to traditional energy companies to fund profitable projects. With oil prices so high, there are plenty of projects to choose from. But

these projects find themselves on the wrong side of this administration’s regulators and the ESG mob, so they don’t get funded. The result is less supply and higher prices.

The misallocation of capital leads to vital industries dying on the vine. This is not merely inflationary, but also a national security threat. We see this playing out in Europe right now, their own early version of ESG having largely banished much-needed fossil fuels. When Russia invaded Ukraine, their moral assessment of fossil fuels and firearms flipped. There’s no consistency with ESG.

When power is centralised, society suffers. Pluralistic institutions like free capital markets protect us from the tyranny of elite power.

On the other side of the ledger, ESG leads to asset bubbles in favoured industries. The resulting bursts harm us all, as we saw in 2008 when the federal government forced banks to provide mortgages to high-risk borrowers in the name of social justice. The resulting defaults nearly brought down our economy.

ESG also leads to just plain bad investing, where high ESG scores trump mundane concerns like balance sheets and income statements. Solyndra, anyone?

If you’re in a large pension plan, these mistakes are being made right now in your portfolio. You will see it in the form of lower returns, which we are witnessing in ESG funds this year. When entire industries — fossil fuels, tobacco, defence, etc. — are excluded from your portfolio, returns will naturally suffer.

A City of London fund manager told The Light: “The ESG scores are created by the Index providers, and MSCI is the most dominant in this space. Index Funds (run by the likes of BlackRock, Vanguard, etc) are all transitioning away from typical passively managed funds to

semi-passive funds utilising the ESG scoring system. They also use the Carbon Intensity score (CI) so that firms with high carbon emissions are omitted from the process. Generally speaking, asset managers utilise a quantitative approach whereby they will maximise the ESG score and minimise the CI score.

“This has ramifications because it means that firms are no longer looking to maximise returns for investors, but rather invest in companies that are politically correct. As Marlo Oaks eloquently puts it, ‘the political weaponisation of the corporate world.’”

There is no real transparency in how the scores are created, and given that asset managers tend to rely on these scores rather than their own in-house research, it is essentially ceding central control of a large part of the investment decision-making process to MSCI. Who at MSCI are making these decisions and what criteria are they using to determine whether a corporation is good or bad? Anyone with an ounce of common sense would realise that this is highly subjective and open to corruption (‘I’ll give you a backhand if you give me a better score’).

The performance of these ESG funds have underperformed the broader index (e.g. FTSE All-Share). Given that ESG funds command higher fees (around 0.1%) compared to a typical passively managed fund (0.02%), then everyone is laughing, except for the people who are actually invested in the funds.

Every single person who owns financial investments (actively or passively managed funds) needs to contact their manager and demand that they are not invested in ESG products. This is especially important for people who own pension funds because a large portion of their pension will now be allocated to these type of funds (the pension fund manager would have rubber stamped it with the investment manager without your consent). It is also important to note that that ESG is expanding into the fixed income space (corporate bonds) and not just confined to equities.

If enough people put pressure on their investment/pension managers, then maybe we have a chance of ending this.

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

New York State had twice as many deaths from Covid-19 than any

China's alliance with Saudis a complete disaster for Biden

NOTHING better illustrates the utter ineptitude of the Biden administration's dealings with the Middle East than Saudi Arabia's decision to forge a strategic alliance with China.

This is a time when Washington should be working overtime to strengthen its ties with long-standing allies like the Saudis, to combat the mounting threat Iran poses to the region's security.

Thanks to the Biden administration's wilful neglect of its relations with the Saudis, Riyadh is instead looking to build a partnership with Beijing, as was evident from the lavish reception given to Chinese President Xi Jinping during his state visit to the kingdom this month.

Rarely has a visiting leader been the recipient of such lavish state pageantry as Xi, after Saudi Crown Prince, Mohammed bin Salman, spared no effort to afford the Chinese leader a warm welcome, which included a jet escort on his arrival.

During his three-day visit, Xi held extensive talks with the Crown Prince, Saudi Arabia's de facto ruler, as well as other senior Saudi officials, and signed a strategic partnership agreement that will deepen ties between Riyadh and Beijing on a range of issues, from defence to technology.

One particularly eye-catching aspect of the agreement was a deal with the Chinese tech giant, Huawei, to supply the Saudis with cloud

computing services and allow high-tech complexes to be built in Saudi cities, according to Saudi officials.

Huawei has been designated a potential security threat by the U.S., with intelligence officials claiming that the company has close links to China's ruling Communist Party, and could be used to conduct spying operations.

That Riyadh is now moving away from its traditional alliance with the U.S. and strengthening its ties with Beijing is a strategic disaster of epic proportions, and serves as a damning indictment of the Biden administration's careless treatment of the Saudis, for which the president is personally to blame.

Biden set the tone for his strained relationship with the Saudi royal family during the 2020 presidential election, when he denounced the kingdom as a 'pariah' state over its involvement in the murder of Saudi dissident Jamal Khashoggi in Istanbul in 2018, although there has never been any audible distress from the Biden administration over Iran's 2007

abduction and presumed murder of ex-FBI agent, Robert Levinson.

Russia's invasion of Ukraine, though, forced Biden to rethink his attitude towards the Saudis, when it suddenly dawned on him that he needed them to increase oil supplies to ease the pressure on world prices.

His efforts achieved little; the Saudis were apparently unimpressed with Biden greeting the Crown Prince with a fist-bump when he visited the kingdom in the summer, and he came away empty-handed, with the Saudis and other Gulf states ignoring his pleas to increase oil production.

Now, thanks to Biden's incompetent management of the U.S.-Saudi relationship, Riyadh is looking to China to protect its interests, a move that confirms the alarming decline in U.S. influence in the region that has taken place in the vacuum created by Biden's leadership.

New Zealand demands citizens report 'conspiracy theorists'

Those who oppose government policies being branded 'terrorists'

THE authoritarian left-wing New Zealand government has ordered citizens to report their friends and family to the police if they suspect them of opposing government policies, including covid measures.

According to literature released by Jacinda Ardern's WEF-infiltrated government, New Zealand citizens who are suspected of being 'conspiracy theorists' will be investigated as terrorists.

Rebecca Kitteridge, director of the New Zealand Security Intelligence Service, explained that there are 'dozens of indicators' that suggest a family member or

Wars are never in the people's interest

THE Ukrainian conflict is becoming a slaughter with no end in sight, and the risk of escalation is growing and can no longer be ignored.

Putin has blood aplenty on his hands, yet the simplistic propaganda narrative - that he randomly went mad one day and invaded Ukraine in a fit of expansionism - is absurd, and fails to acknowledge the well-documented role of the U.S. and NATO in fomenting this conflict.

As a thought-experiment, would those who claim it's none of Russia's business whether Ukraine joins NATO care to imagine London's response if a future independent Scotland were on the cusp of being lured into military alliance with Russia?

For months now, we have been hearing that Putin's troops are demoralised, ill-equipped and close to defeat, yet we are simultaneously fed that Russia poses an imminent expansionist threat to her neighbours such as Finland, Poland or Sweden. These propaganda narratives are mutually exclusive, therefore at least one of them must be false.

The bitterly suffering Ukrainians whom the politicians claim to champion won't benefit much from a pyrrhic victory at the price of reducing their country to rubble, and a pyrrhic or otherwise victory is never certain. General Smedley Butler famously declared that 'war is a racket'.

As always, the vested interests of the Military Industrial Complex and shadowy elites are set to be the only winners. Many of our vulnerable are already huddling hungry this winter. This is in neither our national interest nor our class interest.

U.S./NATO victory via Ukrainian proxy forces will win us no spoils, yet defeat or mischance may conceivably result in escalation and greater harm.

This must be ended now by a negotiated peace, but where is the Peace Movement to demand

it? Could it be that none now dare dream of peace? We must rise to the challenge.

Just over 100 years ago, journalist, H.L. Mencken, wrote: 'The whole aim of practical politics is to keep the populace alarmed (and hence clamorous to be led to safety) by an endless series of hobgoblins, most of them imaginary.'

Even when such a media-conjured hobgoblin has some basis in reality, responding with the fear and alarm the conjurers wish to instil to control us is never helpful.

Nature gifted us an adrenal fear response to shut down thought and prepare our bodies for 'fight or flight' from predators, falling rocks or other physical threats. Where there is no immediate physical danger, this fear response serves only to shut down our conscious minds, and open us to manipulation. The adrenal fear response is entirely maladaptive in withstanding a spiritual, psychological or political danger, and it sickens our bodies as well as our minds.

Is the supposed threat of nuclear war merely another such hobgoblin or fear-phantom? Maybe. Yet even if this danger is in some sense real, an adrenal fear response will not help us to mitigate it. Better dwell upon the profound wisdom contained in the 'Litany Against Fear' from Frank Herbert's 1965 novel, *Dune*.

Bertrand Russell once said: 'war does not determine who is right - only who is left'. It matters little which monger is right; all are wrong for choosing war over the 'jaw-jaw' of negotiation.

There are two paths now: one towards escalation and destruction, and another towards negotiation and peace. In negotiation, both sides must set aside strident nationalism and make compromises for the holistic good of all.

The reality of green energy

Treating the planet better is an easy decision, but as Alan Moran says in *Climate Change: The Facts* "...only one molecule of every 85,000 in the atmosphere is CO₂ of human origin, and yet we are asked to believe that this one molecule drives hugely complex climate change systems." Moran's Co-authors question the notion that consensus exists within the scientific community.

So, why push CO₂ as a demon when there are other options to improve the planet, like phased rollout of soil regeneration/regenerative agriculture, that have positive results, such as a 98% reduction in soil erosion by depth in the Mt Mort experiment and a 100% increase in yield (Mexican National Institute of Forestry, Agriculture and Livestock Research project 2010 in the region of Chiapas), and are little talked about.

Wind and solar energy are being pushed as they are free and renewable, but is this really true?

Succeeding technologies usually replace preceding technologies because they are more efficient and cheaper, a case in point being whale oil, which was the main lamp oil and primary machine lubricant in Europe and the US prior to the 1850's when petroleum and kerosene started to be produced, as refineries and wells became established. These "modern" oils burned cleaner, were more plentiful and made energy cheaper. So much so, the whaling industry that once provided over 50% of New South Wales's exports in 1832 had declined to 1% by 1855, as petroleum took whale oil's place (National Museum Australia).

So, are wind and solar truly more

efficient, cheaper, or better for the planet? As Mark P. Mills who served in the White House Science Office, noted in his 2020 Manhattan Institute report: *Mines, Minerals, and "Green" Energy: A Reality Check*.

- "Building wind turbines & solar panels to generate electricity, as well as batteries to fuel electric vehicles, requires, on average more than ten times the quantity of materials, compared with building machines using hydrocarbons to deliver the same amount of energy to society.
- A single electric car contains more cobalt than 1,000 smartphone batteries; the blades on a single wind turbine have more plastic than five million smartphones; and a solar array, that can power a data centre uses more glass than 50 million smartphones.
- Replacing hydrocarbons with green options under current requirements – never mind aspiring for greater expansion – will vastly increase the mining of critical minerals around the world. For example, a single electric car battery weighing over 1000 pounds (453Kgs), requires extracting and processing some 500,000 pounds (226 metric tons) of materials (that's a large hole in the ground!). Averaged over a car battery's life, each mile (1.6km) of driving in an electric car consumes five pounds (2.26kg) of earth. An internal combustion engine "consumes" around 2 pounds (0.9kg) of liquids per mile (1.6km).
- Oil, natural gas, and coal are needed to produce the concrete, steel, plastic, and purified minerals to build green machines. The energy equivalent of one hundred barrels of oil is used in the process to fabricate a single battery that can store the equivalent of one barrel of oil.
- By 2050, with current plans, the

quantity of worn out solar panels - much of it non-recyclable - will constitute double the tonnage of all today's global plastic waste, along with over three million tons per year of unrecyclable plastics from worn out wind turbine blades. By 2030, more than ten million tons per year of batteries will become garbage."

All machines wear out, and there is nothing currently actually renewable about renewables until there is a commercially viable method of mass recycling. The world MUST engage in the continual extraction, processing, transportation, and ultimate disposal of millions of tonnes of material along with the environmental impact of opening new mines. This results in mining more materials, per unit of energy produced, as we have to include energy costs of extracting ever more minerals. This does not meet the metric of more efficient or cheaper, especially if we have to create multiple backup systems to guarantee supply, so ultimately, we pay more for energy. Cheap energy (along with free markets and the rule of law) is vital for improving living standards. The more a nation's wealth is devoted to energy expenses, the less is available for other endeavours and lowers the standard of living.

Redwood Materials, a former Tesla Engineers' company, believe it will be the first to recycle enough anodes and cathodes for 1 million car batteries annually by 2025, demonstrating how difficult it is to recycle these batteries in a cost-effective manner. For reference, there are approximately 1.446 billion vehicles on the road worldwide, that need to be replaced.

This is why the rush to transition to renewables is contentious. Politicians think it is a vote winner and they have not considered actual



cost and the amount to be replaced. In his book – *Power Hungry*, energy journalist Robert Bryce made the point:

"...if the world's policymakers really want to quit using carbon-based fuels, then we will need to find the energy equivalent of 23.5 Saudi Arabia's every day, and all of that energy must be carbon-free."

The faster we rush to transition, the greater the costs of energy to us and the impact on the earth as we dig it up, consume it and throw it away. Proposed restrictions on fossil fuel production, either by legislation, or by limiting the number of new wells that can be opened, restrict supply which leads to higher fossil fuel prices. And until viable solutions to recycle (which come with their own costs) and ways to increase the lifespan of renewables can be implemented efficiently, the price of energy can only go one way - UP.

CLIMATE science should be less political, while climate policies should be more scientific. In particular, scientists should emphasise that their modelling output is not the result of magic: computer models are human-made.

What comes out is fully dependent on what theoreticians and programmers have put in: hypotheses, assumptions, relationships, parameterisations, stability constraints, etc. Unfortunately, in mainstream climate science, most of this input is undeclared.

To believe the outcome of a climate model is to believe what the model makers have put in. This is precisely the problem of today’s climate discussion to which climate models are central. Climate science has degenerated into a discussion based on beliefs, not on sound, self-critical science. We should free ourselves from the naïve belief in immature climate models. In future, climate research must give significantly more emphasis to empirical science.

There is no climate emergency

A worldwide network of over 1,100 scientists and professionals has prepared this urgent message. Climate science should be less political, while climate policies should be more scientific. Scientists should openly address uncertainties and exaggerations in their predictions of global warming, while politicians should dispassionately count the real costs as well as the imagined benefits of their policy measures.

Natural as well as anthropogenic factors cause warming

The geological archive reveals

that Earth’s climate has varied as long as it has existed, with natural cold and warm phases. The Little Ice Age ended as recently as 1850. Therefore, it is no surprise that we now are experiencing a period of warming.

Warming is far slower than predicted

The world has warmed significantly less than predicted by IPCC on the basis of modelled anthropogenic forcing. The gap between the real world and the modelled world tells us that we are far from understanding climate change.

Climate policy relies on inadequate models

China builds cheap coal plants while West suffers energy crisis

CHINA was responsible for more than half of the new coal power station capacity being built across the world in 2021, with 176 gigawatts of new coal-fired power station projects commenced.

More coal than ever was burned in 2021, despite the COP26 agreement for nearly every country to scale back their coal use. The amount of electricity generated from

coal rose by 9% in 2021. As gas and oil become more expensive, Asian countries are giving themselves the economic advantage Western nations had in the 19th century. In recent decades, however, much of the West has dropped coal and gas in favour of wind turbines and solar panels, which are not sufficient to provide constant power for modern societies.

The number of coal power stations is actually growing in Asia, as new constructions more than offset the closure of old plants. India, South Korea and

Malaysia also increased their coal capacity in 2021, according to the Global Energy Monitor.

Corporate media outlets such as New Scientist and The Guardian are only wringing their hands at the prospect that all of this natural, cheap energy production will raise the Earth’s temperature beyond the 1.5 degree figure agreed at the COP26 summit in Glasgow in 2021.

Proof that a vague and unproven ideology means more to these publications than the average person’s general standard of living,

which is clearly declining rapidly through these misguided but no doubt lucrative political choices.

“It’s a mixed story. Everywhere outside of China, plans for new coal-fired power plants have been scaled back dramatically,” says one of the report’s authors, Lauri Myllyvirta at the Centre for Research on Energy and Clean Air. “However, Chinese firms have continued to announce new coal-fired power stations and there is very clear government backing for that. That’s a worrying sign.”

Those who have bought into climate agenda, formerly known as ‘the weather’ (over which we have no control), have clearly been led to believe so by a decades-long campaign from the establishment to convince them the impossibility of ‘saving the planet’ is of more importance than their own individual needs. When one is hungry, cold, sick or hopeless, how helpful will this dangerously misguided collectivist philosophy be?

How to detox naturally

Easy methods to flush away those toxins

Detox has become such a buzzword - a bit of a meaningless cliché, especially in January. What does it really mean and do we really need to do it?

SOME will always disagree, but in my view, given the toxic cocktail our world has become, and how disturbingly normalised and omnipresent it all is, it's an absolute no-brainer.

From water to food, to clothing, cleaning products, cosmetics, pharma drugs, emf radiation, weird lines in the sky - toxins have infiltrated all areas of our lives. And as dire as it may sound, there really is no escape.

None of us want to be ill or feeling under par, but unfortunately we've been conditioned and manipulated over the last few generations into allowing the likes of government, media and pharmaceutical companies to tell us what's best when it comes to our health and wellbeing.

Possibly the biggest mistake in the history of human evolution, given what's currently unfolding. But thankfully there is much that can be done if, as ever, we look beyond the accepted norm and take matters into our own hands.

There is an art to detoxing, because it happens in two parts: first, toxins must be released from the cells; then they need to exit the body. The art is in the flow - like pouring water through a funnel - pour too fast and the water backs up and overflows. In detox terms, this would mean getting rid of one problem and causing another, and this is possibly why many people give up before they've really got going.

Mastering the art involves using some methods/products that release toxicity from the cells and others which ensure the body's exit points are open and operating efficiently. Below are lists of both with a little information on each suggestion.

My intention here is to give ideas which may or may not resonate with you, which you can research further if you feel called to.

To detox the cells:

- Limit your intake of toxins.
- Consider organic food, natural cleaning products & cosmetics. There are so many alternatives available now or you can even make your own to save on cost.
- Don't suppress acute illnesses. Your body knows what to do; e.g. a fever serves to thin the lymph to remove toxins & pathogens (the head can be kept cool with a flannel), and there are endless natural remedies to ease a multitude of symptoms & help the body release what it needs to.
- Homeopathic pharmacies such as Helios sell various kits which you can then learn how to use for all kinds of first aid situations.
- Hydrate, hydrate, hydrate. The cornerstone of good health; this means water (2 litres a day) but also electrolyte balance. Magnesium is hugely lacking in the soil & therefore pretty much in all of us. In my view & experience, magnesium is the most significant supplement for humans in today's world. Also keeping the colon

healthy with soothing, anti-inflammatory helpers such as aloe vera and linseed tea, as the colon determines much of our hydration level.

- Fasting/intermittent fasting. Food is important, yet demands a great deal of energy to process. During fasting periods, the body can get on with metabolising and repairing.
- Plenty of sleep, and leave a few hours between eating and going to bed.
- Listen to your body. If you feel rubbish after consuming gluten/sugar/alcohol/ coffee/dairy or anything else, you don't have to wait for a professional to validate it for you - cut it out for a few weeks or months and see how you feel. We are generally becoming less tolerant to foods and drinks which are a challenge for the body to process, and leaving them out can often have a very powerful effect on our healing.
- There are many, many supplements, herbs, homeopathic and other natural remedies to aid detox. I can't list them all here, but a few of my favourites include turmeric (a potent anti-inflammatory), concentrated greens such as

chlorella (highly cleansing - keeps grey hair at bay too!), zeolite clay (used internally or in the bath to attract toxins like a magnet and remove them from the body; great for mopping up radiation), zinc (fantastic adrenal and immune support; another important all-rounder), iodine (also great for radiation protection, thyroid health & general metabolism), and magnesium as mentioned above.

Once the toxins are released from the cells, to remove them from the body, look after these hardworking organs:

- Liver. The workhorse of detoxing. Castor oil packs are absolutely fantastic and can be used regularly for maintenance. Herbs such as dandelion and milk thistle are helpful too, as are concentrated greens and juices; particularly celery, and a squeeze of lemon in water first thing.
- Kidneys. Looking after the liver naturally protects the kidneys, as do hydration, electrolytes and pH balance. Also reducing stress. Fear is held in the kidneys and the adrenals sit on top of them, which release cortisol and adrenaline,

associated with our flight or flight response.

- Lymph. The lymphatic system is like a cleansing river running through the body. It needs to flow well, so skin brushing keeps it moving, as does exercise and a healthy body temperature.
 - Lungs. Many toxins are released through the breath, so it pays to breathe well. As obvious as it sounds, very few of us actually do it. Proper breathing also helps regulate the nervous system & hormonal balance. Castor oil packs are great for the lungs, and many people find salt pipes and neti pots helpful too.
 - Blood. Juices, particularly celery, help to cleanse the blood. Exercise is important for healthy circulation, as is efficient breathing for proper oxygen exchange.
 - Skin. Our largest organ and an easy way to remove toxins, as they bypass the internal organs. This is where baths come in; epsom salts (high in magnesium), Himalayan salts, clays & bicarbonate of soda to name a few. Also skin brushing to increase efficiency.
 - Bowels. The all-important final gateway of the internal organs. We really don't want toxins sticking around in here too long as they'll be reabsorbed. Fibre is what we hear about the most, and it is important, although hydration is the key. Enemas and colonics can also be invaluable here, and I can't write about detoxing without including the words 'urine therapy', but I'm well aware these last two suggestions won't float everyone's boat, so on that note I'll leave it there!
